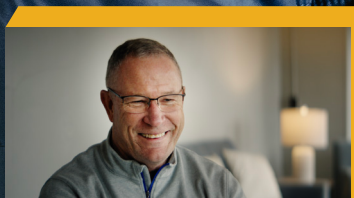

## The Need: A Deep Hunger for More

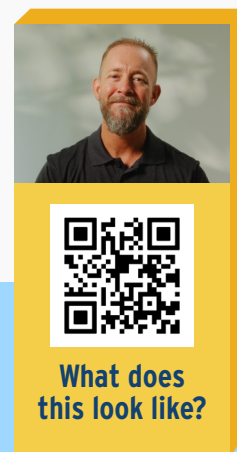
People are longing for an experiential encounter with the fullness of God—less noise, more space; less head, more heart. When we personally encounter the supernatural love of God, everything changes.
