Prayer Guide

- 1** Many people attend church only on Christmas or Easter. Pray for a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit as these folks attend this Sunday. May many realize their personal need for a Savior, and receive Jesus for who He is and what He has done.
- 2** As several departments meet weekly to update, innovate, and create programs, publications, and processes, ask God to keep humility and honesty at the core of our work to further draw hearts and lives into daily revival.
- 3** As Christians, we recognize today as Good Friday, the day Christ suffered on the cross for our benefit, making a way for redemption by a holy God. Pray for those who haven't yet trusted in the saving grace of Jesus Christ.
- 4** As you celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ this Sunday, may you be freshly amazed as you reflect on the glorious victory of life over death—for eternity! Pray for the lost to realize and acknowledge their personal need for a Savior, and to receive Jesus for who He is.
- 5** Raise your voice to be heard proclaiming, **"We serve a risen Savior!"** Rejoice and celebrate with your family and friends that Jesus is alive. Reach out to someone who doesn't know Him, to encourage and love them.
- 6** Intercede for Mike and Dana Lee, Ron and Jane Evans, and others providing key leadership for Life Action. Ask God to strengthen their personal walks with Him and keep their marriages centered in Him, enabling them to lead our ministry with integrity, effectiveness, and attentiveness to God's direction.
- 7** Pray for CREW members in the application process to serve at *Life Action Camp* this summer. Ask God for young men and women to serve wholeheartedly in assisting families to experience life change by enabling spouses and parents to focus undistractedly on each other and their family relationships.
- 8** Please pray for our road team recruiting, asking God to raise up talented musicians, school teachers, drivers, children's ministers, and others to meet the needs of the coming year's travel teams.
- 9** Lift up the staff of Life Action to the Lord today. Ask Him to touch our hearts and minds with a deeper, growing desire to strengthen our love relationship with Him, resulting in a spreading of that love to our neighborhoods and local communities.
- 10** Today, our camp welcomes ladies to **Thrive**, a weekend retreat for women. Pray they experience more of Jesus as they fellowship in His Word, have fun, and eat good food. Ask the Lord to give them fresh glimpses of the life Jesus promised to give.
- 11** Each month, we trust the Lord to provide \$35,000 to our general fund, in addition to event love offerings and registration fees. Ask God to supply this need as only He can.
- 12** Today the Blue Team, Steve and Debby Canfield, and Michael and Jodie Pool start an 8-day Summit Conference at Crossroads Church in Plymouth, Indiana. Ask God to lay a foundation for renewed walks with Him within this body of believers.
- 13** Ask God for fruitfulness in each staff member's personal times with the Lord daily, to undergird them for service in the weeks to come.
- 14** *Life Action Camp* is in need of an additional cook. Ask the Lord to bring a "skilled and ready to serve" individual to fill this role soon.
- 15** Cover Life Action's Communications Team in prayer, asking God to give great wisdom to the speakers, writers, editors, graphic designers, and tech crew as they minister God's Word in many formats to people of all ages and demographics.

16 This weekend, as men gather at *Life Action Camp* for a retreat called **Momentum**, ask the Lord to recharge them in their spiritual walks and encourage them to lead their families with deliberate choices and actions.

17 Today a SoulMates marriage conference begins at Calvary Church in Orland Park, Illinois. As these couples meet for the next two days, ask God to grant them understanding of how they handle conflict and how they can grow in their relationships, honoring Him in their marriages.

18 As the Silver Team sets up for a 4-day THIRST Conference at Faith Baptist Church in Jefferson City, Tennessee, ask the Lord to give Shane and Leigh Black and Zack and Heather Boller clarity in thought and speech as they minister to this group of believers, encouraging them to draw near to Christ and honor Him with fresh obedience.

19 Lift up churches across the nation today as they meet and worship together. Pray for a fresh move of God's Spirit in obedience to Him and an awakening to our need for nationwide revival.

20 Intercede for our staff marriages, that God would keep couples fully engaged with each other, trusting Him together to meet all the challenges and needs of a vibrant relationship and home life.

21 Lift up those working on Base Camp Adventures programs. Ask the Lord to give insight, wisdom, and extraordinary creativity in coming up with ideas, scripts, and messages to reach the hearts of the listeners and produce lives changed for Jesus.

22 As each team member ministers to many people in host homes, churches, and rest stops, pray that their hearts would blaze with compassion for people, with the message of revival, and with renewed obedience to Jesus.

23 Plan to set aside time in two weeks to join the National Day of Prayer on Thursday, May 7, to earnestly seek God for His intervention in our nation's government and affairs. Ask Him to powerfully turn our people to Himself.

24 Cover Life Action's publications in prayer today—both print and online resources—asking God to give great wisdom to the speakers, writers, editors, and tech crews as they minister God's Word in many formats to many demographics (adults, college students, youth, children).

25 Beg God with us for revival and spiritual awakening in America! "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land" (2 Chronicles 7:14).

26 The Silver Team, Shane and Leigh Black, and Zack and Heather Boller begin an 8-day Energize Conference at First Baptist Church in Cheraw, S. Carolina, today. Lift the congregation in prayer as they seek Him, asking for hearts to be set on fire for Jesus and what He has for each individual.

27 Pray for believers to be light in the midst of the darkness, confusion, and bewilderment gripping the world around us. Pray that we remain steadfast in holding onto His truths in changing times. "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (John 8:32 ESV).

28 Pray for the children impacted this year in Base Camp and Happy Heart City. Pray that their hearts will be stirred with desire to follow Jesus in loving obedience for the rest of their lives.

29 Every year, *Life Action Camp* depends on CREW members to help with housekeeping, kitchen duties, and childcare for weekend events and Family Camps. Ask God to raise up young adults committed to helping guests have an outstanding week learning to follow God as a family.

30 Ask the Lord to bring the right person to fill an Administrative role at the camp. We need a willing, skilled individual to serve in this capacity, ideally before Family Camp begins at the end of next month.
